Also will provide direct behavioral support for CLA's (Community Living Arrangement's) in Cheshire. Psychological testing requirements for ICF (Intermediate Care Facility). May serve as a Qualified Mental Retardation Professional; perform related duties as required.

**General Experience:** A Master's or Doctorate degree in psychology, educational psychology, rehabilitative psychology, community psychology or experimental psychology from a program accredited by a regional educational board and one (1) year of experience in treating and/or working with the clients in the appropriate specialty served by the agency.
