Duties may include but not limited to: The Recovery Support Specialist is part of a multi-disciplinary team and functions as a recovery education to the ACT team consumers; facilitates groups including WMR, self-esteem and any other groups as assigned; plays a key role in the development of recovery plans and community skill training for the ACT team consumers; is required to travel in the community with ACT team consumers; performs related duties as required.

General Experience and Training: Six (6) months experience as a Recovery Support Specialist Trainee.

Special Requirement: Must possess, retain, and carry valid Connecticut Driver's License. Travel in the community is required. **Incumbents in this class must possess and maintain Recovery Support Specialist Certification.**

Eligibility Requirement: State employees currently holding the above title or those who have previously attained permanent status or candidates who possess the general and special experience and training may apply.

Note: Applicants will be selected in accordance with reemployment, SEBAC, transfer, promotion, collective bargaining unit contract language, merit employment lists and DMHAS affirmative action goals. Therefore, State employees will generally be considered before applicants from outside State service.
