**EXAMPLE OF DUTIES**

Participates in the planning and support team process. Conducts functional assessments and develops individual treatment plans. Makes recommendations based on assessments, provides initial and on going training for licensed CTH providers and families. May conduct group therapy and family therapy and crisis intervention, participates in clinical and interdisciplinary meetings, prepares case notes and reports; may provide consultations according to specialized expertise; may write grant proposals and renewals; may conduct Restrictive Procedures Audits; provides necessary documentation to present to Human Rights and Programmatic Review Committee. Interfaces with community supports and clinicians. Candidate must be able to travel within the region; schedule requires flexibility according to agency needs; caseload size varies; considerable knowledge of general psychological theory and its application to treatment, rehabilitation and research programs; knowledge of statistics and experimental design; considerable interpersonal skills; considerable oral and written communication skills, considerable ability to select, score, conduct and interpret objective and projective psychological tests; considerable ability to develop treatment plans; ability to conduct individual and group psychotherapy; ability to provide consultation and training services; supervisory ability.

**EXPERIENCE & TRAINING**

**General Experience:**

A Master's degree in community psychology, educational psychology, experimental psychology, psychology or rehabilitative psychology from a program accredited by a regional educational board AND three (3) years of experience in conducting psychological testing, assessment and evaluation including one (1) year in treating and/or working with clients in the appropriate specialty serviced by the agency.

**Note:**

For State Employees the experience component shall be interpreted to be at the level of a Developmental Specialist 1.

**Substitution Allowed:**

A Doctorate degree in community psychology, educational psychology, experimental psychology, psychology or rehabilitative psychology from a program accredited by a regional educational board AND two (2) years of experience in treating and/or working with clients in the appropriate specialty serviced by the agency may be substituted for the General Experience.
