General Experience: One year of experience as a licensed clinical social worker.

Special Requirements:

1. Incumbents in this class must possess and retain a license to practice clinical social work pursuant to Sec. 20-195 (m) through (r) of the Connecticut General Statutes.
2. Must possess and retain a current/valid Motor Vehicle Operator's License. May be required to travel.

Duties: This position serves on an interdisciplinary treatment team that provides community behavioral health treatment. Responsible for providing case management services; individual, group and family therapy; intakes, psychosocial assessments, risk assessments and crisis intervention. Advocates and develops networks of social and clinical services to assist clients in meeting identified needs. Communicate and work collaboratively with contract agencies, community providers, state and community hospitals around the provision of client care. Responsible for facilitating person centered recovery plan meetings and developing and implementing recovery plans; participate in case conferences and critical incident reviews. Provide supervision to employees in a lower job class as assigned. Documents treatment in electronic health record, completes reports in accordance with agency policies and procedures. Participates in organizational committees and trainings as directed.

Working Conditions: Incumbents in the class may be exposed to some risk of injury from assaultive and/or abusive clients.

Note: The filling of this position will be in accordance with reemployment, SEBAC, transfer, promotion and merit employment rules, if applicable.
