Eligibility Requirement: State employees currently holding the above title or those who have previously attained permanent status may apply. Candidates who possess the General Experience and Training and the Special Requirements may apply.

Duties may include but not limited to: Responsible for providing recovery oriented, age and developmentally appropriate services to young adults in a community based setting. Works within a multi-disciplinary team providing trauma sensitive, clinical services to young adults with multiple and complex clinical diagnoses and high risk behaviors including but not limited to psychosexual, developmental and trauma histories. Provides individual, group and family therapy utilizing clinically appropriate therapeutic interventions. Utilizes the Department of Mental Health and Addiction Services (DMHAS) initiatives in the provision of treatment; e.g. DBT, IDDT, Trauma Treatment, Person Centered Planning, etc. Responsible for developing and implementing recovery plans in collaboration with the client, their family, and other treatment providers. May provide some case management duties as needed. May provide supervision to employees in a lower class.

General Experience and Training: One year of experience as a licensed clinical social worker.

Special Requirements:

- Incumbents in this class **must possess and retain** a license to practice clinical social work pursuant to Sec. 20-195 (m) through (r) of the Connecticut General Statutes.
- Incumbents **must possess and retain** a current motor vehicle operator's license. Incumbents in this class may be required to travel.

Note: Applicants will be selected in accordance with reemployment, SEBAC, transfer, promotion, collective bargaining unit contract language, merit employment lists and DMHAS affirmative action goals. Therefore, State employees will generally be considered before applicants from outside State service.
