**Eligibility Requirement:**

The Department of Rehabilitation Services, Bureau of Education and Services for the Blind, is presently accepting applications to fill one (1) Education Supervisor position. The successful candidate will have experience leading teachers of the visually impaired in their daily assignments, Performing on site visits to schools to evaluate individual education programs; Coordinating the administration of special projects for visually impaired individuals such as low vision services, career education services or vocational rehabilitation. Experience planning and implementing expanded core curriculum activities for students and training seminars for school district staff to work with visually impaired students is highly desirable. Strong written and verbal communication skills are essential. This position requires independent decision making.

**Knowledge, Skills and Abilities:**

Knowledge of philosophy, methods and technologies of education with particular emphasis upon blindness and visual impairment; knowledge of social factors which influence attitudes and behaviors of blind or visually impaired individuals and their families; knowledge of supervisory principles and techniques; ability to understand and explain complex written material; ability to prepare reports; ability to develop effective relationships with those contacted in the work; ability to teach.

**General Experience:**

Eight (8) years of professional employment in education of the blind or visually impaired.

**Substitution Allowed:**

1. College training may be substituted for the General Experience on the basis of fifteen (15) semester hours equaling one-half (1/2) years of experience to a maximum of four (4) years for a Bachelor's degree.
2. A Master's degree may be substituted for one (1) additional year of the General Experience.

**Special Requirement:**

Educator Certification issued by the Connecticut State Board of Education leading to professional certification within three (3) years of employment.

**Note:** The filling of this position will be in accordance with reemployment, SEBAC, transfer, promotion and merit employment rules, if applicable.
