**Eligibility Requirement:**

State employees currently holding the above title or those who have previously attained permanent status may apply for lateral transfer.

**Examples of Duties:**

This position serves as Director of the DDS Eligibility Unit. Additional assignments include a role with the Commissioner's Institutional Review Board (IRB) and DDS HIPAA compliance. Provides consultation on difficult assignments and develops behavioral adjustment and vocational rehabilitation programs. Analyzes experimental data and indices of program effectiveness. Writes reports in a manner suitable for professional publication. Makes oral presentations in administrative hearing and other settings. Consults with community agencies and organizations. May address professional and lay groups. Performs related duties as required.

**General Experience:**

A doctorate degree in psychology and one (1) year's postdoctoral experience as a psychologist working under the supervision of a licensed psychologist.

**Special Requirements:**

1. Incumbents in this class must possess and retain a license to practice psychology in Connecticut. Any person employed by the State of Connecticut prior to July 1, 1985 with a title in the Psychology series of the classified service shall be exempt from the above licensure requirement pursuant to Public Act 613, Section 119(c). For certain positions the appointing authority may require state licensure.
2. Incumbents in this class may be required to travel.

**Note:** The filling of this position will be in accordance with reemployment, SEBAC, transfer, promotion and merit employment rules, if applicable.
