**Example of Duties:** The candidate chosen for this position will serve as a member of an airport fire and crash team on an assigned shift and function in the following areas: fire prevention, equipment maintenance, emergency medical services, communications and fire fighting and rescue.

**Knowledge, Skills and Abilities:** Knowledge of fire fighting, fire prevention and crash rescue techniques as applied to airports and aircraft crash situations; knowledge of fire inspection and prevention techniques; knowledge of emergency Medical techniques; interpersonal skills; oral and written communication skills; ability to evaluate emergency situations and develop effective courses of action; ability to work under pressure; ability to prepare reports.

**Experience and Training:** National certification by the National Board of Fire Service Professional Qualifications or the International Fire Service Accreditation Congress or State Certification by the Connecticut Fire Academy that meet the provisions of the National Fire Protection Association Firefighter 2.

**Substitution Allowed:** Successful completion of prescribed training and probationary requirements set forth in the class of Protective Services Trainee.

**Special Requirement:**

1. Candidates must maintain membership in the CT. Air Nat'l Guard for at least 6 years after being hired and possess Air Force AFSC 3E7X1 or be eligible to attend Air Force Firefighting School within 6 months of hire.
2. Candidates will be required to complete training as set forth by Air Force and Air Nat'l Guard policies and regulations including handling of hazardous materials.
3. Candidates must possess and retain a valid CT class II Motor Vehicle Operator license, military operator license and DOD security clearance.
4. Candidates must have reached their 18<sup>th</sup> birthday.
5. Candidates may be required to obtain and maintain Emergency Medical Technician certification.

**Character Requirements:** In addition to the checking of references and of facts stated in the application a thorough background investigation of each candidate will be made before persons are certified for permanent appointment.

**Physical Requirement:** Candidates must possess general good health and must possess and retain sufficient strength, stamina, agility and visual auditory acuity necessary to perform the duties of the class. Candidates may be required to pass a physical examination.

**Working Conditions:** Incumbents in this class may be required to lift moderate equipment, danger of injury or loss of life during crash rescue operations, significant mental stress of responding to life and death emergencies and strongly disagreeable conditions including exposure to weather, loud noises and chemicals.

**Note:** The filling of this position will be in accordance with reemployment, SEBAC, transfer, promotion and merit employment rules, if applicable.
