**Description of Duties:**

- Participating in the allocation, distribution, and retirement of CO2 Allowances in accordance with CT's laws implementing the Regional Greenhouse Gas Initiative (RGGI)
- Collecting and analyzing data pertaining to greenhouse gas and other air pollutant emissions and energy production from electric generating units subject to RGGI and other state and federal air pollution control laws.
- Participating in regional staff working groups involved in the operations of RGGI
- Developing and implementing a system to track CO2 emissions associated with electricity imports into the RGGI region.
- Monitoring the distribution and deployment of RGGI CO2 allowance auction proceeds to ensure compliance with CT's laws implementing RGGI and alignment with the Comprehensive Energy Strategy
- Creating reports, briefing materials, and presentations regarding the operations of RGGI for the Commissioner's office and stakeholders.
- Participating in the development and implementation of regulatory policy to meet federal emissions guidelines applicable to greenhouse gas emissions from the electricity generating sector.
- Compile and improve upon periodic greenhouse gas inventories
- Collect and evaluate greenhouse gas emissions from motor vehicles
- Collect, review and evaluate energy savings and avoided emissions associated with energy conservation, load management, and weatherization policies of the Department.
- Collecting and evaluating environmental program data to inform energy planning activities (e.g. development of the Integrated Resource Plan).

**Knowledge, Skills and Abilities:**

- Excellent computer skills, including Word, Excel, PowerPoint, and experience with Access and other relational databases;
- Demonstrated experience in evaluating and administering regulations, policies and guidelines;
- Basic understanding of current energy markets, related technologies, and associated greenhouse gas emissions and other environmental impacts;
