General Experience: Licensure as a clinical social worker in the State of Connecticut

Special Requirements: Incumbents in this class must possess and retain a license to practice clinical social work pursuant to Sec. 30-195 (m) through (r) of the Connecticut General Statutes. Must possess and retain a current/valid Motor Vehicle Operator's License - may be required to travel.

Duties may include but not limited to: Provides clinical oversight and treatment support to clients residing in the Young Adult Services Transitional Housing Program. Ability to lead and provide support and clinical direction to paraprofessional staff. Participates as a member of a multidisciplinary treatment team. Participates in the development and shift oversight of behavioral programming. Participates in the implementation of treatment plans and skill building modules. Documents clients progress in the medical record. Motivate and support clients in their Recovery while assisting them in establishing a natural support system. Ability to coordinate responsive care to clients in crisis.

Note: Applicants will be selected in accordance with reemployment, SEBAC, transfer, promotion, collective bargaining unit contract language, merit employment lists and DMHAS affirmative action goals. Therefore, State employees will generally be considered before applicants from outside State service.
