General Experience: Licensure as a Clinical Social Worker in the State of Connecticut

Special Requirements: Incumbents in this class must possess and retain a license to practice clinical social work pursuant to Sec. 20-195 (m) through (r) of the Connecticut General Statutes. Must possess and retain a current/valid Motor Vehicle Operator's License. May be required to travel.

Preferred Candidate: Will have Certification as a Brain Injury Specialist (CBIS).

Duties: The regional ABI Community Integration Specialist (CIS) provides services to persons with brain injury throughout the Western Connecticut Mental Health Network. The CIS is responsible for processing all referrals to the ABI Community Services Program within the designated services area; serving as a link for clients to in-patient services; providing or arranging for clinical consultations; assisting in the development of treatment plans; serving as liaison to private/public services within the appropriate community; providing monitoring of services for DMHAS ABI clients and providing support to consumers, family members and conservators. The CIS receives ongoing training regarding brain injury services available within the particular geographic region as well as throughout the state. The CIS coordinates with other programs within DMHAS and with other Departments within the State/local services constellation that can provide services, funds, etc., to persons with brain injury.

Note: The filling of this position will be in accordance with reemployment, SEBAC, transfer, promotion and merit employment rules, if applicable.
