General Experience: Licensure as a Clinical Social Worker in the State of Connecticut

Special Requirements: Incumbents in this class must possess and retain a license to practice clinical social work pursuant to Sec. 20-195 (m) through (r) of the Connecticut General Statutes. Must possess and retain a current/valid Motor Vehicle Operator's License. May be required to travel.

Duties: Provides clinical oversight and treatment support to clients residing in the Young Adult Services/Transitional Housing Program. Ability to lead and provide support and clinical direction to paraprofessional staff. Participates as a member of a multidisciplinary treatment team. Participates in the development and shift oversight of behavioral programming. Participates in the implementation of treatment plans and skill building modules. Documents clients progress in the medical record. Motivate and support clients in their Recovery while assisting them establish a natural support system. Has knowledge of development stages relevant to young adults, ages 18-25 years. Understanding of trauma sensitive services and practices. Ability to coordinate responsive care to clients in crisis.

3. **All Other Candidates:** Individuals must complete a State Employment Application for Examination and Employment (CT-HR-12). Resumes and Curriculum Vitae can be provided as supplemental information but will only be accepted if attached to a fully completed application. The position number must be noted at the bottom of Page One of the State of Connecticut Application (CT-HR-12).
