Example of Duties: Responsibilities include but are not limited to: knowledge of the materials, methods, tools and equipment involved in maintaining the heating, ventilating and air conditioning of a medium size campus of approximately 150,000 square feet of program space, 12 buildings over 27 acres. Applicant must hold a current D-1, D-2 or S-1 license. Preference will be given to applicants with experience in repair and operation of HVAC, refrigeration equipment and steam boilers central heating plant.

General Experience: Four (4) years of experience in the particular trade area indicated by the parenthetical title.

Special Experience: Two (2) years of the General Experience must have been performing skilled trade functions in the specific trade area.

Substitution Allowed: Graduation from a vocational or technical school with a diploma designating completion of subject requirements in a maintenance trade area may be substituted for two (2) years of the General Experience.
