MINIMUM QUALIFICATIONS: Master's degree in Mathematics or a related field including successful completion of at least 18 credits of graduate-level Math courses.

Applicants who do not meet the minimum qualifications as stated are encouraged to put in writing precisely how their background and experience have prepared them for the responsibilities of this position. They must also provide appropriate references. Exceptions to the degree requirements may be made for compelling reasons.

RESPONSIBILITIES: Under the supervision of the Division Director, the Instructor will teach all levels of mathematics from developmental through multi-variable Calculus, consistent with a strong mathematics background, using a variety of instructional techniques. The Instructor will incorporate web-based homework systems (e.g. MyMathLab, Web Assign, Hawkes Learning Systems) as needed. The Instructor will integrate computer technology into curriculum and make real-world connections through appropriate activities. The Instructor will also utilize strong communication and interpersonal skills while exercising judgment and tact conducive to a collegial environment. In addition, the Instructor will assess student performance and may assume additional responsibilities including student advisement; committee work; participation in special college projects; development of new innovative instructional techniques, course offerings, or programs; and participate in community service consistent with the institutional mission. Within applicable contractual provisions, teaching faculty and non-teaching professional staff are committed to the operation of the college five days a week, which may include evenings, Saturdays or Sundays.
