**Eligibility Requirement:**

The Department of Children and Families is seeking two (2) Registered Nurse, Per Diem vacancies to be filled at the Connecticut Juvenile Training School in Middletown. The Connecticut Juvenile Training School (Girls Unit) is a secure, female adolescent and young adult facility; located at 915 River Road, Middletown, CT 06457. Responsibilities include administering medications; conducting nursing assessments, providing admission and discharge nursing assessments; and providing other nursing services in compliance with standards of excellence for nursing care. Applicants with experience working with adolescent girls are preferred; and all applicants that possess a commitment to gender responsive, family focused, trauma informed, teaching and engagement approach to nursing practice and a willingness to work within a therapeutic milieu are strongly encouraged to apply. The DCF Girls secure Unit will be a short term, rapid reintegration unit for girls in need of brief stabilization. Hours of work may include first, second and third shifts, weekends, and holidays. Incumbents in this class must possess and retain a license or temporary permit as a Registered Nurse in Connecticut.

**Knowledge, Skills and Abilities:**

Knowledge of principles and practices of nursing; considerable interpersonal skills; oral and written communication skills

**General Experience:** Graduation from an accredited nursing program.

**Special Requirement:**

- 1) Incumbents in this class must possess and retain a current license or temporary permit to practice professional nursing in Connecticut.
- 2) Incumbents in this class may be required to be fluent in a foreign language or proficient in the use of American Sign Language in certain designated positions.

**Character Requirement:**

In addition to the checking of references and of facts stated in the application, a thorough background investigation of each candidate may be made before persons are certified for permanent appointment.

**Working Conditions:**
