Eligibility Requirement:

Candidates must have applied for and passed the IT Analyst 2 exam and be on the current certification list promulgated by the Department of Administrative Services for this classification. State employees currently holding the above title or those who have previously attained permanent status may apply for lateral transfer. Applicants will not have the opportunity to take the exam prior to the above closing date to qualify for this particular vacancy. Reemployment/SEBAC candidates will be given first priority.

Required Skills:

Experienced Report Developer, employing extensive knowledge of SQL Server 2008, SQL Reporting Services, Microsoft Visual studio and Report Builder. Also skilled at web design and development, XML, with Microsoft IIS and Microsoft.net development experience, C#, Visual Studio, ASP.Net, and ADO.Net. From a database administration/operations skills perspective, experience with SQL Server 2008. Systems Integration, system architecture and design skills. Must be able to effectively communicate and document technical concepts in writing, i.e. interface, system design etc.

Preferred Skills:

Experience with large scale enterprise applications deployed using .NET. Project management and leadership skills including the ability to communicate effectively and collaborate with co-workers; problem solving skills, and experience in the Motor Vehicle Industry preferred.

General Experience:

Six years of experience in information technology (IT) operations, programming, systems/software development or another IT related support area.

Special Experience:

One year of the General Experience must have been performing professional information technology work in one the following areas: (1) Installation and support of microcomputer hardware, software and operating systems. (2) Analysis, design and development of information systems. (3) Network hardware and software installation and support. (4) Network hardware and/or software problem diagnosis and resolution. Note: For state employees this is interpreted at the level of Information Technology Analyst 1.

Substitutions Allowed:

College training in management information systems, computer science or information technology related area may be substituted for the General Experience on the basis of fifteen semester hours equaling six months of experience to a maximum of four years for a Bachelor's degree. A Master's degree in management information systems, computer science or electrical engineering may be substituted for one additional year of the General Experience.
