**Duties may include but not limited to:** The Supervising Psychologist provides clinical supervision, leadership, and direction for the Psychology Internship Program and manages the daily clinical and administrative operations of the Transitional Treatment and Evaluation Program. The Director of the Internship Program is responsible in maintaining current knowledge of and communication with APA regarding CoA Guidelines and Principles; implementing regulations as required, maintaining accreditation status through timely submission of annual reports, dues payments, other CoA communications and completing APA annual reports, coordinating with Human Resources regarding NMS Match, job offers, hiring, position authorization, updating program brochures annually and developing annual orientation schedule. Provide sophisticated level of supervision to (3) interns to assist in development of full array of comprehensive clinical skills including individual and group therapy, intake and crisis assessments, family therapy, and psychological testing. The Transition, Treatment and Evaluation Program is a small short-term program designed to provide assessment for diagnostic clarification and referral to the appropriate level of care within the service system. Other responsibilities of this position include participation in DMHAS Initiatives including Behavioral Health Homes, Same Day Access, Trauma-Informed Care and implementation of the Electronic Health Record (EHR). The Supervising Psychologist provides clinical leadership to the agency as part of Program Management, Risk Management and Case Consultations.

**Eligibility Requirement:** Considerable knowledge of abnormal and clinical psychology and other psychological disciplines; considerable knowledge of sources, uses, administration, and interpretation of a wide variety of psychological tests; considerable ability to make diagnoses, develop treatment plans and conduct psychotherapy; considerable ability to interface clinical programs with multidiscipline approaches

**General Experience:** A Doctorate degree in Clinical or Counseling Psychology and three (3) years of post-doctoral experience as a licensed clinical psychologist.

**Special Requirements:** Incumbents in this class must possess and retain a license to practice psychology in Connecticut.

Any person employed by the State of Connecticut prior to July 1, 1985 with a title in the psychology series of the classified service shall be exempt from the above licensure requirements pursuant to Public-Act 613, Section 119 ©. For certain positions, the appointing authority may require State licensure. Incumbents in this class may be required to be fluent in a foreign language or proficient in the use of the American Sign Language. Incumbents in this class may be required to travel.

**Note:** The filling of this position will be in accordance with reemployment, SEBAC, transfer, promotion and merit employment rules, if applicable.
