Pursuant to Section 51-88 of the Connecticut General Statutes, an incumbent who has not been admitted to practice law may not "assume, use or advertise the title of lawyer, attorney and counsel at law, counselor at law, attorney, counselor, attorney and counselor, or an equivalent term, in such a manner as to convey the impression that s/he is a legal practitioner of law."

Tax Attorney 2

General Experience: Three (3) years of experience in the practice of law handling tax matters or in the preparation and presentation of cases in litigation.

Special Requirement: Candidates must be admitted to practice law in the State of Connecticut.
