This position is responsible to define business and systems requirements and provide lead programming support and technical administration for Authority databases and applications. Participate in user consulting, systems analysis, general systems design, detail systems design and creation of technical documentation throughout software development lifecycle. Develop and/or maintain web and windows-based applications to support various departments within CHFA. Manage the implementation of various software projects

Responsible for providing lead programming support including developing, implementing, testing, enhancing, documenting and deploying web based applications. Define project scope and create detailed project plan for the design, development, and implementation of information systems – including all deliverables, milestones, and resource allocations. Identify and organize meeting with stakeholders to solicit input, gain buy-in, and manage expectations. Track and report upon project progress and adjust project plan as circumstances dictate.

Responsible for understanding the CHFA business model, product lines, business processes and legacy systems through meetings with stakeholders, comparisons to HFA's and exposure to systems and documentation. Provide second-tier customer support for applications, web and windows applications as well as 3<sup>rd</sup> party products and services. Create/compile user manuals, training guides, operation manuals, test plans and other project and product documentation as needed. Create ad-hoc downloads, reports and queries to satisfy program monitoring. Graphic design – create consistent, user orientated, aesthetically pleasing user interfaces.

Minimum of BS/BA in Business Administration or Computer Science or equivalent level of education and experience; five to eight years' experience working with application design/development. Experience in developing, testing, deploying and maintaining data driven web application in and object-oriented programming environment using Visual Basic, ASP, ASP.NET and other development tools is essential. Programming experience in Microsoft SQL Server is preferred. Considerable knowledge with Microsoft .NET framework and development experience in Microsoft Technologies using Microsoft Visual Studio is recommended and preferred.
