There is a Transportation Engineer 2 (Engineering) position opportunity available in the Bureau of Engineering and Construction, Division of Design Services, AEC Applications Section. This position is in the P-4 (Engineering and Scientific) bargaining unit.

Position Description: AEC Applications is responsible for developing and establishing electronic design standards and supporting computer-aided engineering and construction applications. The position will be responsible for providing support for several engineering software applications. The primary focus will be assisting with the management of Bentley software packages MicroStation, InRoads and ProjectWise. The Transportation Engineer 2 position will collaborate and meet regularly with fellow staff members to solve software issues and implement new software technology. This position will also provide training to State Engineers and assist them with related software issues; develop workflows and manuals; provide direction to Consulting Engineering firms using the CTDOT Digital Design Environment; assist with the configuration and maintenance of CT DOT MicroStation and InRoads resource files and workspace.

Preferred Knowledge, Skills and Abilities: Considerable knowledge of principles and practices of civil engineering and related computer applications, considerable interpersonal and oral and written communication skills; considerable analytical, problem solving and technical report development skills; ability to interpret and apply principles of information systems and technologies; intimate knowledge of CTDOT Digital Design Environment; and familiarity with the Department's functions and organization.

Eligibility: Candidates must meet the minimum qualifications listed in the job specification (see job specification at <http://das.ct.gov/hr/jobspecNew/jobDetail.asp?FCC=6273>). Candidates must have passed the Transportation Engineer 2 (Engineering) exam and be on a current certification list promulgated by the Department of Administrative Services. State employees who currently hold this title or those who have previously attained permanent status in this title since their most recent hire date may apply for lateral transfer.
