Eligibility Requirement:

A current license as an advanced practice registered nurse issued by the Connecticut Department of Public Health.

Minimum Qualifications:

Provides appropriate nursing and/or health care services to patients including clinical assessments, treatments, diagnosing medical conditions, assessing emergencies, ordering diagnostic studies, prescribing medications, leading cardiac arrest codes and documenting medical care. Considerable knowledge of nursing principles and clinical therapeutic models; considerable knowledge of relevant state and federal laws, statutes and regulations; knowledge of state, federal and local health care agencies and programs; knowledge of pharmacology as it relates to advanced nursing practice; considerable interpersonal skills; considerable oral and written communication skills; considerable clinical assessment and evaluation skills; administrative ability.

Preferred Experience:

There are currently two positions available. One will be primarily responsible for programs. The other will be responsible for handling clinical issues. Both positions will require a candidate with superior written and oral communication skills. Candidates for both positions need to be self motivated, able to perform work independently but still function collaboratively as part of a multi-disciplinary team of healthcare professionals.

The programming position will be responsible for developing, managing and assessing healthcare programs delivered to the inmate population. The ideal candidate will be familiar with utilization management, as well as conducting audits and validating data from programs. Candidates should have experience conducting research and be familiar with current programmatic trends in the healthcare field.

The ideal candidate for the clinical position will possess detailed clinical knowledge as well as experience conducting complex research and analysis regarding medical issues. The agency is specifically looking for applicants with experience in internal medicine, primary care, or orthopedics. Candidates should also possess knowledge of current treatment trends and practices. Education and/or experience dealing with infectious disease as well as public health programs and policies is also a plus.
