- Location:** The primary location will ultimately be Stamford, CT. The incumbent will initially perform examinations throughout the state of CT, and some travel to New York City may be required.

General Knowledge: The incumbent will become part of the continuous monitoring team participating on routine examinations and investigations for large, complex international financial institutions, but will initially be trained to examine domestic financial institutions throughout the state of CT during the two year training period. This will require the assessment of the financial condition and regulatory and statutory compliance of said institutions through ongoing communication with institution management and staff, and the review of financial and operational documentation, including financial statements and reports, loan files, investments, management policies, risk management programs and models, licensing information and other data. The position requires close coordination with federal agency peers and team members. The incumbent will be required to prepare monitoring and examination commentary, correspondence, and reports on a timely basis and will also be required to perform related duties as required.

Preferred Skills and Ability: Excellent oral and written communication skills are required, as well as strong interpersonal skills and an ability to work independently on complex concepts and issues.
