The successful candidate will teach selected graduate courses in counselor education, coordinate and administer clinical field work placements, perform organizational duties related to Advanced Official Certificate Program in Professional Counseling (OCP), and contribute actively and effectively to student growth, service, and scholarship. Candidates are expected to be committed to multiculturalism and working with a diverse student body.

***Required Qualifications:***

- Earned doctorate in counselor education (ABD candidates will be considered; completion is required within one year of appointment.)
- Experience as a professional counselor
- Demonstrated administrative and organizational skills for clinical coordination
- Expertise in counselor training and supervision, and mentoring graduate students
- Qualified to teach core counseling courses, e.g., theory and techniques, group counseling, ethics
- Demonstrate experience or potential for research and scholarship
- Commitment to serving culturally diverse communities
- Eligible for Connecticut's Licensed Professional Counselor (LPC)

***Preferred Qualifications:***

- Graduate from a CACREP accredited program
- Successful teaching experience in higher education
- Experience in clinical field work development and placement at the graduate level
- Demonstrated knowledge of Professional Counselor licensing and certification requirements at both national and state levels
