Duties include: monitoring and providing consultation to assigned Young Adult Services (YAS) community program sites, including oversight of the transitions of young adults from the DCF system of care to DMHAS YAS. They will be responsible for oversight of service plan development, coordination, compliance, consultation to locally based community treatment teams, coordination with regionally based community programs, hospital monitoring teams, training of staff, and triaging of clients; provide oversight of program budgets, program development initiatives, and outcome measures. The position will interface with DCF and community program staff on a daily basis to ensure effective transitions and monitor ongoing placements and programming. This position is critical to public health, welfare, and safety due to the type and severity of dysfunction of the clients in this program.

General Experience:

Four (4) years of professional experience in Behavioral Health Care and a Master Degree in a clinical discipline, Public Health Administration, Health Care Administration or Hospital Administration.

Special Experience:

Two (2) years of the General Experience must have been supervising professional staff.

For state employees, this is at the level of Behavioral Health Unit Supervisor; Nurse Supervisor or Supervising Clinician.

Special Requirements: Incumbents in this class must maintain the appropriate current license for clinical social work, marital and family therapist, professional counselor, alcohol and drug counselor, registered nurse or clinical psychologist. Incumbent will be required to travel and must have a valid motor vehicle operator's license.
