Duties may include but are not limited to: Incorporating a recovery focused system of care including programs such as supported employment and education, peer services and PUSH programing; monitor the peer stipend program and provide guidance and support to recovery support specialists and is the advisor to the consumer council; will monitor compliance with all fidelity reviews, adherence to assigned contracts and approve stipend budgets. This position will be responsible for all rehabilitative services in all three SWCMHS sites in Bridgeport and Stamford and will serve as liaison for community providers of rehabilitative services; will be responsible for administrative and clinical supervision, performance evaluation, and developing programming within the assigned units.

General Experience: Four (4) years of professional experience in Behavioral Health Care and a Master Degree in a clinical discipline, Public Health Administration, Health Care Administration or Hospital Administration.

Special Experience: Two (2) years of the General Experience must have been supervising professional staff.

For state employees, this is interpreted at the level of Behavioral Health Unit Supervisor; Nurse Supervisor or Supervising Clinician.

Special Requirement: Must possess, retain, and carry valid Driver's license. Travel in the community is required. Incumbents in this class must maintain the appropriate current license for clinical social work, marital and family therapist, professional counselor, registered nurse, psychologist or alcohol and drug counselor.

Non-Examined refers to Section 5-219 of the Connecticut General Statutes which permits appointment of candidates to competitive positions without formal examination when a professional license, professional degree, accreditation or certificate is a mandatory requirement to a class.
