State or national EMS-Instructor certification, provider level certification in ACLS, PALS, PHTLS and BLS, with instructor preferred status. A minimum of four (4) years of college teaching or an equivalent combination of work and teaching experience is required. A minimum of four (4) years of field experience as a paramedic is also required. Applicants should be able to show evidence of commitment to the mission of a comprehensive community college with an urban, non-traditional, multicultural student population

General Experience:

Under the direction and supervision of the Program Coordinator, the incumbent is responsible for program and curriculum development, maintaining national program accreditation, scheduling courses, part-time faculty recruitment, program evaluation and assessment, articulation with senior institutions and student recruitment and retention.
