Position Description: The Connecticut Department of Transportation anticipates filling various Connecticut Careers Trainee (CCT) positions in the Bureau of Policy and Planning, at the DOT Administration building in Newington, CT. Opportunities in the following areas are anticipated Coordination, Modeling and Crash Data; and Roadway Information Systems. The CCT training program will be either one or two years (See Experience and Training Requirements section below). Upon successful completion of the CCT training program, the incumbent will be promoted to the target classification of Transportation Planner 1. These positions are full time; 40 hours per week and are open to the public. These positions are in the P-4 bargaining unit and require the possession of a valid Driver's License.

These positions require a minimum of a Bachelor's degree. Interviews will be limited to those applicants whose education and qualifications most closely meet the requirements of each position.

MINIMUM QUALIFICATIONS REQUIRED

KNOWLEDGE, SKILL AND ABILITY:

Oral and written communication skills; ability to acquire knowledge and skills required for the target classification; ability to understand, evaluate and solve problems by exercising judgment and logic; ability to read, interpret and understand written material; ability to perform basic arithmetical computations; ability to interpret charts, graphs and tables; learning and reasoning ability; ability to establish and maintain cooperative relations with superiors, associates and general public.

2 year training program: Possession of a Bachelor's degree

1 year training program: Master's Degree in civil engineering, transportation, urban, regional or environmental planning.
