The Connecticut Juvenile Training School is a secure, male adolescent and young adult facility located at 1225 Silver Street, Middletown, CT 06457. Responsibilities include administering medications; conducting nursing assessments; conducting admission and discharge nursing assessments including plans for continuing care; maintaining records and making reports; providing nursing services in compliance with standards of nursing excellence; participating as a member of an interdisciplinary team in the assessment, development, implementation and evaluation of resident treatment; managing an assigned case load as primary care nurse; acting as a health education resource to this unit; acting in collaboration with the health care team and interdisciplinary team. Applicants with experience working with adolescent males are preferred and all applicants should possess a commitment to family focused, trauma informed nursing practice with an emphasis on health education.

General Experience:

Two years experience as a registered professional nurse.

Special Experience - one year of the general experience must have been working with the types of patients and/or clients serviced by the agency.
