Eligibility Requirement:

The Department of Children and Families currently has a vacancy for one (1) Maintainer at the Connecticut Juvenile Training School in Middletown, CT. This is a full-time (37.5 hours weekly), 1st shift. This hazardous duty position performs laundry services, weekly sanitation inspections, waste disposal, vermin and pest control, storage and inventory of residential property boxes. Physical environment requirements, oversight of toxic and caustic materials, and other safety standards pertaining to general Housekeeping duties. This position is critical to this department, to maintain the health & safety, sanitary environment, critical compliance standards, and the day to day operation of a large scale agency, and performs related duties as required. Current DCF employees having permanent status in this classification must submit an NP-2 Lateral Transfer Request Form. State employees currently holding the above title or those who have previously attained permanent status may apply for lateral transfer.

Knowledge, Skills and Abilities:

Some interpersonal skills; some oral and written communication skills; ability to follow oral and written instructions; ability to learn policies and procedures; ability to operate, care for and perform minor maintenance on tools and equipment used in daily work; some ability in simple record keeping.

General Experience:

Any experience and training which provide the knowledge, skills and abilities listed above.

Special Requirement:

Incumbents in this class may be required to possess appropriate current licenses or permits.

Physical Requirement:

Employees appointed to positions in this class must have adequate physical strength, stamina, physical agility, visual and auditory acuity and must maintain such physical fitness as to be able to perform the duties of the class. A physical examination may be required.

Working Conditions:

1. Incumbents in this class may be required to lift moderate to heavy weights and may be exposed to extreme weather conditions and risk of injury from equipment and assaultive and/or abusive patients and/or clients.
2. Incumbents in this class may be required to complete an asbestos removal program consistent with EPA guidelines for operations and maintenance and use protective equipment such as respirators and safety goggles.
