Eligibility Requirement: The Department of Children and Families is recruiting for a full-time (40 hours) Director of Food Services at the Connecticut Juvenile Training School. Interested candidates must have applied for and passed the current Director of Food Services exam and be on the current certification list promulgated by the Department of Administrative Services for this classification. State employees currently holding the above title or those who have previously attained permanent status may apply for lateral transfer.

Knowledge, Skills and Abilities: Applicants must be Safe Food certified as well as physically fit and able to pass annual certification in Safe Crisis Management - the verbal and physical intervention techniques used at the Connecticut Juvenile Training school. Experience in the Food Service department and in a secure facility is preferred.

General Experience: Eight (8) years experience in institutional or commercial food service involving 800 or more complete meals daily.

Special Experience: Two (2) years of the General Experience must have been in a supervisory capacity.

Note: For state employees the Special Experience will be interpreted at the level of Assistant Director of Food Services

Substitution Allowed: College training in dietetics, hotel/restaurant management, nutrition or a related field may be substituted for the General Experience on the basis of fifteen (15) semester hours equaling one-half (1/2) year of experience to a maximum of four (4) years of a Bachelor's degree.

Note: The filling of this position will be in accordance with reemployment, SEBAC, transfer, promotion and merit employment rules, if applicable.
