The Connecticut Siting Council is recruiting for a full-time Siting Analyst 1 (Environmental) to be under-filled at the level of Connecticut Careers Trainee.

**Eligibility Requirement:**

Candidates on Reemployment/SEBAC lists will be given first consideration.

**General Experience:**

In order to be considered for this opportunity, applicants must possess a bachelor's and/or master's degree in biology, earth science, engineering, natural resources management or physical science, land use planning, or comparable/related major.

**Training:**

The incumbent will receive on the job training necessary to satisfy the minimum qualifications for the target class of Siting Analyst 1. For candidates possessing a bachelor's degree the training program will be 2 years. For candidates possessing a master's degree the training program will be 1 year. Upon successful completion of the prescribed training program the incumbent will be promoted to the target class without examination.

**Description of Duties: (For Target Class)**

Manage Docket/Petition Proceedings, which includes, but is not limited to:

- Review filings for completeness;
- Analyze costs and public need and environmental impact of construction, operation, and modification of telecommunications, hazardous waste and energy facilities;
- Develop legal record, through preparation of pre-hearing interrogatories and cross-examination of witnesses at hearings;
- Coordinate public hearing activities ;
- Develop Staff Reports, Findings of Facts, Opinions, and other documents;
- Process requests for tower sharing and modifications/upgrades on existing facilities, reviewing compliance with statutory requirements, FCC guidelines, and relevant structural engineering codes;
- Maintain database files of telecommunications facilities in the State of Connecticut;
- Prepare/update the Statewide Telecommunications Plan;
- Contribute to the maintenance of the agency website.

**Knowledge, Skills and Abilities: (For Target Class)**

Interpersonal skills; oral and written communication skills; ability to understand and interpret state and federal regulations and policies relative to energy, telecommunications and hazardous waste facility siting; ability to understand and interpret technical reports, data and material.
