Serves as a senior member of Lower County Clinical Team. Assists Team Leader and in the absence of the Team Leader provides clinical and administrative management and supervision to Team Members. **Duties may include but not limited to:** conducts individual clinical assessments including comprehensive data gathering and timely assessment updates; develops and evaluates person-centered integrated recovery treatment plans insuring client involvement in process; provides crisis assessment and management using available support systems; provides individual, group and family/couples psychotherapy with particular emphasis on dual diagnosis, DBT, trauma services and IPS; and performs other related duties.

**Eligibility Requirement:** State employees currently holding the above title or those who have previously attained permanent status may apply for lateral transfer.

**General Experience:** One year of experience as a licensed clinical social worker.

**Special Requirements:** Incumbents in this class must possess and retain a license to practice clinical social work pursuant to Sec. 20-195 (m) through (r) of the Connecticut General Statutes. Incumbents in this class may be required to be a certified Substance Abuse/HIV Supervisor. Incumbents in this class may be required to travel.

**Working Conditions:** Incumbents in the class may be exposed to some risk of injury from assaultive and/or abusive clients.

**Note:** The filling of this position will be in accordance with reemployment, SEBAC, transfer, promotion and merit employment rules, if applicable.
