Duties may include but not limited to: Serves as a senior member the Community Support Program Team A. Assists Team Leader and in the absence of the Team Leader provides clinical and administrative management and supervision to Team Members. **Duties include but are not limited to:** conducts individual clinical assessments including comprehensive data gathering and timely assessment updates; develops and evaluates person-centered integrated recovery treatment plans insuring client involvement in process; provides crisis assessment and management using available support systems; provides individual, group and family/couples psychotherapy with particular emphasis on dual diagnosis, DBT, trauma services and IPS.

General Experience and Training: One year of experience as a licensed clinical social worker.

Special Experience and Training: Incumbents in this class must possess and retain a license to practice clinical social work pursuant to Sec. 20-105 (m) through (r) of the Connecticut General Statutes. Incumbents in this class must possess and retain a valid driver's license and may be required to travel.

Eligibility Requirement: State employees currently holding the above title or those who have previously attained permanent status or candidates who possess the general and special experience and training may apply.

Note: Applicants will be selected in accordance with reemployment, SEBAC, transfer, promotion, collective bargaining unit contract language, merit employment lists and DMHAS affirmative action goals. Therefore, State employees will generally be considered before applicants from outside State service.

Application Instructions: Due to the large number of lateral transfer forms and applications received, it is extremely important to note the Position Number (found on the posting) on the DMHAS Lateral Transfer Request Form (upper right-hand corner) and at the bottom of Page One of the State of Connecticut Application for Examination or Employment (CT-HR-12)

To be considered for this position:

1. **DMHAS employees who are lateral transfer candidates** (example: CSWA applying to a CSWA posting) must submit a completed DMHAS Lateral Transfer Form. Lateral Transfer Request Forms received without a position number will not be processed.
2. **DMHAS employees who are promotional/demotional candidates** must submit the State of Connecticut Application for Examination and Employment (CT-HR-12). The position number must be noted at the bottom of Page One of the State of Connecticut Application (CT-HR-12).
3. **All other applicants** must complete a State Employment Application for Examination and Employment (CT-HR-12). Resumes and Curriculum Vitae can be provided as supplemental information but will only be accepted if attached to a fully completed application.
