General Experience and Training: Licensure as a clinical social worker in the State of Connecticut.

Special Requirements: Incumbents in this class must possess and retain a license to practice clinical social work pursuant to Sec. 20-195 (m) through (r) of the Connecticut General Statutes. Incumbents in this class may be required to travel.
