Eligibility Requirement: State employees who possess the general and special experience and training, currently hold the above title or those who have previously attained permanent status in the above title may apply.

Knowledge, Skills and Abilities: Will function as a Crisis Clinician responsible for the following duties: Conducting crisis assessments, both on-site and in the field at a variety of community locations. Attend to the safety of clients and staff in all MCT interventions. Respond to crisis telephone calls. Participate in the development of high-risk intervention plans. Participate in team problem-solving. Participate in the development of MCT treatment plans with staff, clients and available collateral individuals. Implement an individualized MCT treatment plan. Conduct follow-up monitoring of the client through In-reach or field visits to assess level of stability and degree of participation in the treatment plan. Provide supportive counseling as needed to clients and family. Under supervision, perform toxicology screens both at RVS and in the field..

General Experience and Training: Must be currently classified as a CSW or possess licensure as clinical social worker in the State of Connecticut

Special Requirements: Possess/Retain CSW Connecticut License; must possess valid motor vehicle license.

Note: Applicants will be selected in accordance with reemployment, SEBAC, transfer, promotion, collective bargaining unit contract language, merit employment lists and DMHAS affirmative action goals. Therefore, State employees will generally be considered before applicants from outside State service.

Application Instructions:

Due to the large number of lateral transfer forms and applications received, it is extremely important to note the **Position Number (found on the posting)** on the DMHAS Lateral Transfer Request Form (**upper right-hand corner**) and at the bottom of Page One of the State of Connecticut Application for Examination or Employment (CT-HR-12)

To be considered for this position:

1. **DMHAS employees who are lateral transfer candidates** (example: Mental Health Assistant 1 applying to a Mental Health Assistant 1 posting) must submit a completed DMHAS Lateral Transfer Form. Lateral Transfer Request Forms received without a position number will not be processed
2. **DMHAS employees who are promotional/demotional candidates** must submit the State of Connecticut Application for Examination and Employment (CT-HR-12). The position number must be noted at the bottom of Page One of the State of Connecticut Application (CT-HR-12).
3. **All other applicants** must complete a State Employment Application for Examination and Employment (CT-HR-12). Resumes and Curriculum Vitae can be provided as supplemental information but will only be accepted if attached to a fully completed application.
