Candidates must have applied for and passed the Information Technology Analyst 2 exam and be on the current certification list promulgated by the Department of Administrative Services for this classification. State employees currently holding the above title or those who have previously attained permanent status may apply for lateral transfer.

Applicants will not have the opportunity to take the exam prior to the above closing date to qualify for this particular vacancy.

DUTIES INCLUDE: responsibility for the network connectivity and support of the mobile storage devices used for the upcoming EMR on the DMHAS enterprise network. Responsible for platform recoverability assessments and business impact analysis for mobile devices connected to the DMHAS network. Performs functions associated with vulnerability and security risk assessments on the DMHAS network; performs functions in support of investigative and virus activity; provides second or third level support for network connectivity to the new Electronic Medical Record; ability to diagnose and resolves moderate network problems utilizing traces, hardware diagnostic tools, software aids, network management systems and utilities; must have considerable logical and analytical skills; must display considerable problem solving skills; and must have interpersonal skills to maintain good working relations with all DMHAS users; images PCs and reconfigures user specific settings; Configures and installs application packages; applies patches and fixes as needed, researches issues with OS and hardware and trouble shoots and resolves issues. Performs other related duties as required.
