Duties include: Responsible for planning healthcare services for broad segments of the population, including the means by which services can be financed; evaluating new technologies; implementing regulations and assessing their impact and for preparing reports for other governmental entities including the legislature, as well as specifically recommending courses of action; oversees the administrative functions of DMHAS Waivers and Home and Community Based Transition Programs including budgets, resources and outcomes to ensure compliance with federal Waiver Assurances and requirements of CMS; liaison with DSS and CMS, legislators regarding compliance and assurances; coordinates and facilitates meetings with appropriate ASO and DSS; participates in budget meetings; ensures that DMHAS Programs particularly the Waiver and Home and Community Based Transition Programs operate in accordance with the approved design of the programs, meets statutory and regulatory assurances and requirements, achieves desired outcomes and identifies opportunities for improvement; coordinates collection of data for waivers/transition programs; interprets the data and recommends quality improvement; interprets and facilitates resources pertaining to the Waiver/Home and Community Based Transition Programs, the monitoring of the OPA lawsuit settlement in collaboration with the court appointed monitor, and Money Follows the Person Program, prepares or oversees the preparation of applications, reports and responses representing DMHAS for Statewide Services; performs related duties as required.

General Experience:

Four (4) years of professional experience in Behavioral Health Care and a Master Degree in a clinical discipline, Public Health Administration, Health Care Administration or Hospital Administration.

Special Experience:

Two (2) years of the General Experience must have been supervising professional staff.
