**Eligibility Requirement:** State employees currently holding the above title or those who have previously attained permanent status may apply for lateral transfer.

**Duties include:** developing comprehensive community-based behavioral support plans; consultation and training of community providers; YAS program planning, development, and evaluation. Additional training and supervision in functional behavioral analysis, positive behavioral programming and neuropsychological and psychological testing will be offered. Expertise in the assessment of persons with pervasive developmental disabilities, neurobehavioral conditions, attachment and trauma issues as well as functional assessment of severe and challenging behaviors is preferred.

**General Experience and Training:** A doctorate degree in clinical or counseling psychology and one (1) year's post doctoral experience as a psychologist working under the supervision of a licensed psychologist.

**Special Requirements:** **1)** Incumbents in this class must possess and retain a license to practice psychology in Connecticut. Any person employed by the State of Connecticut prior to July 1, 1985 with a title in the psychology series of the classified services shall be exempt from the above licensure requirements pursuant to Public Act 613, Section 119(c). For certain positions, the appointing authority may require State licensure. **2)** Incumbents in this class may be required to travel and are required to possess and retain a valid motor vehicle operator's license.
