The Crisis Clinician is assigned to the Mobile Crisis Team. Duties include, but are not limited to: Conducting crisis assessments, both on-site and in the field at a variety of community locations. Attend to the safety of clients and staff in all MCT interventions. Respond to crisis telephone calls. Participate in the development of high-risk intervention plans. Participate in team problem-solving. Participate in the development of MCT treatment plans with staff, clients and available collateral individuals. Implement an individualized MCT treatment plan. Conduct follow-up monitoring of the client through Inreach or field visits to assess level of stability and degree of participation in the treatment plan. Provide supportive counseling as needed to clients and family. Under supervision, perform toxicology screens both at RVS and in the field.

**General Experience:** Licensure as a clinical social worker in the State of Connecticut.

**Special Experience:**

1. Incumbents in this class must possess and retain a license to practice clinical social work pursuant to Sec. 20-195 (m) through (r) of the Connecticut General Statutes.
2. Incumbent will be required to travel and must possess and retain a current motor vehicle operator's license.
3. Incumbents must pass a Department of Corrections background check.
