Eligibility Requirement: State employees currently holding the above title or those who have previously attained permanent status may apply for lateral transfer.

Duties may include but not limited to: The candidate will be a member of an interdisciplinary treatment team providing a variety of intensive clinical and case-management services to adults with a history of severe mental illness, medical problems, and co-occurring disorders. The candidate will be responsible for clinical assessment, individual and/or family counseling, medication monitoring and management, community outreach, coordination of community care, crisis prevention and intervention, development of professional relationships with community providers including medical providers. The candidate will provide nursing assessment and coverage to the outpatient department of CRMHC including providing direct nursing care, responding to on site medical emergencies, coverage of medication clinics, providing consultation to team on complex medical problems of team clients; other related duties as assigned.

Knowledge, Skills and Abilities: Considerable knowledge of psychiatric nursing and clinical therapeutic models of client-care with emphasis on interdisciplinary team approaches; knowledge of psychiatric illnesses and medications.

General Experience: Three (3) years of professional nursing experience.

Special Experience: One (1) year of the General Experience must have been at the level of Head Nurse working with the type of clients indicated by the parenthetical title.

Substitutions Allowed: 1) A Bachelor's degree in nursing may be substituted for one (1) year of the General Experience. 2) A Master's degree in nursing may be substituted for one (1) additional year of the General Experience.

Special Requirements: 1) Incumbents in this class must possess and retain a license as a registered nurse in Connecticut. 2) Incumbents in this class must possess and retain a current/valid Motor Vehicle Operator license. 3) Incumbents in this class are required to travel.
