Duties may include but not limited to: As a clinician in CMHC Community Forensic Services and a member of the DMHAS state-wide Connecticut Offender Re-entry Program, the individual will regularly travel to provide services within at least four Department of Correction facilities for inmates with psychiatric disorders meeting CORP requirements. The individual will be supervised by a clinician of a higher grade. At DOC facilities, will provide screening and develop psychosocial assessments for CORP-eligible inmates through clinical interviews; develop individual recovery/ treatment plans for inmates in collaboration with DOC discharge planners and co-lead weekly skill building CORP groups, providing coverage for other CORP clinicians as indicated. At release, provides clinical case management for CORP clients in New Haven to facilitate connection to residential, medical and behavioral health care services as indicated, monitoring and evaluating effectiveness of treatment plans. As indicated, completes CMHC clinical assessment, housing and other referrals, other necessary documentation. Completes reports in accordance with agency, Connecticut Offender Re-Entry Program and accrediting bodies; maintains social work treatment and standards as required; performs related duties as required.

General Experience and Training: Licensure as a clinical social worker in the State of Connecticut.

Special Experience and Training:

- ◇ Incumbents in this class must possess and retain a license to practice clinical social work pursuant to Sec. 20-195 (m) through (r) of the Connecticut General Statutes.
- ◇ Incumbent will be required to travel and must possess and retain a current motor vehicle operator's license.
- ◇ Incumbents must pass a Department of Corrections background check.

Eligibility Requirement: Candidates who possess the general and special experience and training may apply. State employees currently holding the above title or those who have previously attained permanent status may apply. DMHAS employees who possess the general and special experience may apply for promotion opportunity.

Note: The filling of this position will be in accordance with reemployment, SEBAC, transfer, promotion and merit employment rules.
