Duties may include but not limited to: This licensed Clinical Social Worker will independently conduct psychosocial assessments, eliciting psychiatric and medical history, including family, legal, educational, employment, housing and other social information, as well as mental status evaluations. Will also assess level of care needs at regular intervals throughout a client's treatment. Will provide both office- and community-based services, including individual and group treatment. Family and significant others will be engaged as clinically indicated and agreed upon by the individual in recovery. This Clinical Social Worker will possess or develop competence in evidence-based practices, including, but not limited to, Dialectical Behavior Therapy, Integrated Dual Diagnosis Treatment and Illness Management and Recovery. Will develop crisis response plans and manage crises as needed. Will be responsible for collaborating with team members and the individual in recovery, to develop person-centered recovery plans that include measurable goals and objectives, as well as interventions. Will lead designated team staff of lower class, to design and implement individualized rehabilitative skill building interventions in the community, in partnership with individuals in recovery; demonstrating knowledge of community resources, the stages of recovery, stage-appropriate interventions, and motivational enhancement techniques. Will assess, coordinate, and monitor, link and plan services in collaboration with other team members. Will document all care provided in clinical records, in compliance with agency, billing and accreditation standards. May supervise social work trainees and/or staff of lower class; participating in the preparation of annual performance appraisals as indicated. May perform related duties as required.

General Experience: Licensure as a Clinical Social Worker in the State of Connecticut

Special Requirement: Must possess, retain, and carry valid Connecticut Drivers License. Travel in the community is required.

Eligibility Requirement: State employees currently holding the above title or those who have previously attained permanent status or candidates who possess the general and special experience and training may apply.

Note: Applicants will be selected in accordance with reemployment, SEBAC, transfer, promotion, collective bargaining unit contract language, merit employment lists and DMHAS affirmative action goals. Therefore, State employees will generally be considered before applicants from outside State service.
