Duties may include but not limited to: Provide clinical case management services to clients on caseload; implement treatment plans for clients on caseload; assist with linking clients to community resources; provide individual and/or group skill building and education to clients within assigned team; Assesses, provides, and/or links appropriate, least restrictive supportive interventions to address consumer issues such as housing, family support, medical needs, productive use of time, meaningful work experience, leisure activities, social relationships, and spiritual concerns; provide appropriate crisis intervention services, including outreach; completes required agency documentation; performs related duties as required.

Eligibility Requirement: Candidates must have applied for and passed the Community Clinician exam and be on the current certification list promulgated by the Department of Administrative Services for this classification. State employees currently holding the above title or those who have previously attained permanent status may apply for lateral transfer. **Applicants will not have the opportunity to take the exam prior to the above closing date to qualify for this particular vacancy.**

Special Requirement: Must be bilingual in English and Spanish. Incumbent in this class is required to have ability in Spanish oral and written communication.

Note: Applicants will be selected in accordance with reemployment, SEBAC, transfer, promotion, collective bargaining unit contract language, merit employment lists and DMHAS affirmative action goals. Therefore, State employees will generally be considered before applicants from outside State service.

Application Instructions: DMHAS employees who are lateral transfer candidates (example: Community Clinician applying to a Community Clinician posting) must submit a completed DMHAS Lateral Transfer Form. Lateral Transfer Request Forms received without a position number will not be processed. DMHAS employees who are promotional/demotional candidates must submit the State of Connecticut Application for Examination and Employment (CT-HR-12). The position number must be noted at the bottom of Page One of the State of Connecticut Application (CT-HR-12). All other applicants must complete a State Employment Application for Examination and Employment (CT-HR-12). Resumes and Curriculum Vitae can be provided as supplemental information but will only be accepted if attached to a fully completed application.
