Eligibility Requirements: Candidates must have applied for and passed the Community Clinician exam and be on the current certification list promulgated by the Department of Administrative Services for this classification. State employees currently holding the above title or those who have previously attained permanent status may apply for lateral transfer. **Applicants will not have the opportunity to take the exam prior to the above closing date to qualify for this particular vacancy.**

Duties may include but not limited to: This Community Clinician will participate in the provision of counseling, case management and skill building interventions to a caseload of clients on our Community Support Plus Team, under the supervision of a licensed independent practitioner. Interventions will be provided in both office and community settings. This Community Clinician may assist in the development of treatment plans for new clients, and will implement client treatment plans ongoingly; assisting clients to link with community support systems and agencies, and monitoring client progress. Will provide education and skill training to clients in the activities of daily living, to facilitate development of greater independence in community living. Will monitor client adherence to medications, coordinate meetings with team psychiatrists or nurses, and other community providers. Will participate in crisis intervention as needed. May transport clients to and from appointments. Will complete all required documentation according to agency and regulatory standards. May lead paraprofessional staff of a lower level. Will perform related duties as assigned

Special Requirements: Incumbents must possess and retain a current motor vehicle operator's license.

Note: Applicants will be selected in accordance with reemployment, SEBAC, transfer, promotion, collective bargaining unit contract language, merit employment lists and DMHAS affirmative action goals. Therefore, State employees will generally be considered before applicants from outside State service.

Application Instructions: Due to the large number of lateral transfer forms and applications received, it is extremely important to note the **Job Posting Number (found on the posting)** on the DMHAS Lateral Transfer Request Form (**upper right-hand corner**) and at the bottom of Page One of the State of Connecticut Application for Examination or Employment (CT-HR-12).

To be considered for this position:

DMHAS employees who are lateral transfer candidates (example: Mental Health Assistant 2 applying to a Mental Health Assistant 2 posting) must submit a completed DMHAS Lateral Transfer Form. Lateral Transfer Request Forms received without a position number will not be processed.

DMHAS employees who are promotional/demotional candidates must submit the State of Connecticut Application for Examination and Employment (CT-HR-12). The position number must be noted at the bottom of Page One of the State of Connecticut Application (CT-HR-12).

All other applicants must complete a State Employment Application for Examination and Employment (CT-HR-12). Resumes and Curriculum Vitae can be provided as supplemental information but will only be accepted if attached to a fully completed application.
