**Eligibility Requirement:** This is a competitive position. Candidates must have applied for and passed the EXAM TITLE exam and be on the current certification list promulgated by the Department of Administrative Services for this classification. State employees currently holding the above title or those who have previously attained permanent status may apply for lateral transfer. Applicants will not have the opportunity to take the exam prior to the above closing date to qualify for this particular vacancy.

**Duties may include but not limited to:** Community Clinician on the Forensics team will provide the following; Jail Diversion & Veterans' Jail Diversion case management, engagement with identified PSRB clients transitioning to the community, both Temporary Leave(TL) and Conditional Release(CR) monitoring, attendance of treatment plan reviews(TPR's) at CVH, all treaters meetings and PSRB hearings for assigned clients. Connecticut Offender Reentry Program (CORP), this includes, but is not limited to; collaboration with network providers, limited case management, PSRB progress reports, PSRB 6 month reports, testify at PSRB hearings, supervision of breathalyzer and urine drug screens as mandated, admitting clients into the electronic health record, documenting services into the electronic health record. Providing coverage for other program staff as needed. May provide education to clients in community living and activities of daily living skills; monitors PRSB clients compliance with Memorandum of Decision (MOD); transportation of clients in the community; ongoing forensic risk assessment; other related duties as assigned.

**Special Experience and Training:** Incumbents in this class must possess and retain a valid driver's license and may be required to travel.

**Note:** Applicants will be selected in accordance with reemployment, SEBAC, transfer, promotion, collective bargaining unit contract language, merit employment lists and DMHAS affirmative action goals. Therefore, State employees will generally be considered before applicants from outside State service.

**Application Instructions:**

Due to the large number of lateral transfer forms and applications received, it is extremely important to note the **Position Number (found on the posting)** on the DMHAS Lateral Transfer Request Form (**upper right-hand corner**) and at the bottom of Page One of the State of Connecticut Application for Examination or Employment (CT-HR-12)

**To be considered for this position:**

1. **DMHAS employees who are lateral transfer candidates** (example: CSW applying to a CSW posting) must submit a completed DMHAS Lateral Transfer Form. Lateral Transfer Request Forms received without a position number will not be processed.
2. **DMHAS employees who are promotional/demotional candidates** must submit the State of Connecticut Application for Examination and Employment (CT-HR-12). The position number must be noted at the bottom of Page One of the State of Connecticut Application (CT-HR-12).
3. **All other applicants** must complete a State Employment Application for Examination and Employment (CT-HR-12). Resumes and Curriculum Vitae can be provided as supplemental information but will only be accepted if attached to a fully completed application.
