Eastern Connecticut State University is inviting applications for a full-time staff position in Counseling and Psychological Services. The Center provides services that include individual and group counseling; crisis intervention; consultation; outreach services; and training of master's and doctoral level practicum students.

Counselor will provide individual and group psychotherapy; intake; crisis intervention; supervision of master's and doctoral level trainees; training and community outreach services. Participate in university committees and activities. Perform other related duties as assigned by the Director.

Minimum Qualifications: Requires a doctorate in clinical or counseling psychology from an APA-accredited program, APA-accredited internship, and Connecticut license eligibility. Knowledge of developmental issues of college students and demonstrated knowledge of and sensitivity to multicultural issues required.

Desired Qualifications: Three to five years of experience in a college counseling center is strongly preferred. Effective therapist with generalist clinical skills and demonstrated experience assessing and intervening with a range of clinical and mental health issues. Experience with group psychotherapy particularly men's issues. Well-developed clinical supervision skills. Strong interpersonal skills, including strong oral, written and listening communication capabilities. Excellent presentation and training skills desired. Strong assessment and diagnostic experience would be beneficial.

This is a 10 month position, involving some non-traditional hours with a competitive salary and benefits.
