Eligibility Requirement: Candidates must have applied for and passed the Residential Program Supervisor exam and be on the current certification list promulgated by the Department of Administrative Services for this classification. State employees currently holding the above title or those who have previously attained permanent status may apply for lateral transfer. Applicants will not have the opportunity to take the exam prior to the above closing date to qualify for this particular vacancy.

Knowledge, Skills and Abilities: Considerable knowledge of mental retardation procedures and terminology; considerable knowledge of modern methods of dealing with persons with mental retardation; considerable knowledge of rehabilitative and interdisciplinary process; considerable interpersonal skills; ability to administer activities of a unit; ability to analyze and resolve day to day problems of persons with mental retardation; supervisory ability.

General Experience: Four (4) years of experience in the care and supervision of persons with mental retardation

Special Experience: One (1) year of the General Experience must have been in a supervisory capacity at the level of a Supervising Developmental Services Worker 1 or 2.

Substitution Allowed: College training, preferably in an educational, nursing or social science field, may be substituted for the General Experience on the basis of two (2) years of college education equalling one (1) year of experience to a maximum of two (2) years.

Special Requirement: 1. Incumbents in this class may be required to be bilingual or fluent in American Sign Language. 2. Incumbents in this class may be required to travel.

Physical Requirement: Incumbents in this class will be required to possess physical and emotional health for efficient performance of duties; a physical examination may be required.
