The Department of Children and Families currently has a vacancy for a Registered Nurse, Per Diem, at the Albert J. Solnit Children's Psychiatric Center North Campus in East Windsor, CT (formerly Connecticut Children's Place). This is a per diem position and will provide direct professional nursing care to a variety of patients/clients. Hours of work may include all shifts, weekends, and holidays. Incumbents in this class must possess and retain a license or temporary permit as a Registered Nurse in Connecticut.

**Special Requirement:** Incumbents in this class must possess and retain a current license or temporary permit to practice professional nursing in Connecticut. Incumbents in this class may be required to be fluent in a foreign language or proficient in the use of American Sign Language in certain designated positions

**Special Conditions:** Employees working for more than one state facility will be required to complete Dual Employment forms and prove that conflict of interest does not exist. Primary agency scheduling will be given top priority to those employees who are permanently employed by one agency and per diem in a second agency.

**Character Requirement:** In addition to the checking of references and of facts stated in the application, a thorough background investigation of each candidate may be made before persons are certified for permanent appointment.
