The Unified School District #2 of the Department of Children and Families has an immediate employment opportunity for a State School Teacher. This position is a 12 month, full-time position (35 hour per week), located at the Albert J. Solnit Center North Campus (formerly CT Children's Place School) in East Windsor, CT, a school operated within a residential treatment facility for children and youth. Certification in Special Education (065) is required. Additionally, a highly qualified status in language arts or math is required; preference will be given to those candidates who are highly qualified in both subject areas. Responsibilities include, but are not limited to: the conducting of formal and informal student assessments including achievement testing and interest inventories; the planning for and direct instruction of students; participation in planning and placement team (PPT) meetings; development of individual education plans (IEPs); providing individualized teaching including 1-1 tutoring and/or resource room instruction; and classroom instruction designed to implement curriculum which is aligned with the student's Individualized Education Plan (IEP) and the CT's Curriculum Frameworks. Additional duties include participating in treatment team meetings, assessing and managing student behavior; maintaining student academic records and evaluating student progress by formal evaluations and by progress monitoring.

**Special Requirement:** Employment in this class is conditional upon possession of a valid Connecticut State Board of Education teaching certificate appropriate to the teaching assignment. Incumbents in this class may be required to possess and retain a current Connecticut Motor Vehicle operator's license.

**Character Requirement:** In addition to the checking of references and of facts stated in the application, a thorough background investigation of each candidate may be made prior to appointment.
