EXAMPLES OF DUTIES

Performs maintenance and/or construction and repair (both corrective and preventive) operations on a wide variety of building equipment. Performs landscape duties including mowing, trimming and snow removal. Assists Qualified Craft Workers or other higher level employees in the trades' areas, may operate trucks and power equipment; performs related duties as required.

EXPERIENCE & TRAINING

General Experience: Two (2) years' experience in one of the following areas: 1. One of the skilled trades
2. Landscape maintenance or vegetable gardening 3. Operation of motor trucks or large buses. The experience area should reflect the needs of the position.

Substitutions Allowed: Graduation from a vocational or technical school with a diploma designating completion of subject requirements in a maintenance trade area may be substituted for the General Experience.

Special Requirements: Incumbents in this class may be required by the appointing authority to possess appropriate current licenses or permits. Incumbents in this class must have adequate physical strength, stamina, physical agility and visual and auditory acuity and must maintain such physical fitness as to be able to perform the duties. A physical examination may be required. Incumbents in this class may be required to lift moderate to heavy weights and may be exposed to significant levels of dust, heat, noise, extreme weather conditions and risk of injury from equipment. Incumbents in this class may be required to complete an asbestos removal program consistent with EPA guidelines for operations and maintenance and may be required to use protective equipment such as respirators and safety goggles
